

Privacy Policy

ARAMARK Limited ("we") are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This policy (together with our [Terms of Use](#)) sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it.

For the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998 (the "Act"), the data controller is ARAMARK Limited of 250 Fowler Avenue, IQ Business Park, Farnborough, Hampshire, GU14 7JP.

Information We Collect

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our site www.aramark.co.uk ("our site"). We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with our site.
- Information that you provide for the purpose of responding to a job advertisement on our site or any site linked to our site and information that you provide for the purpose of speculatively informing us about your interest in employment opportunities.
- If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.
- We may also ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes, although you do not have to respond.
- Details of your visits to our site and the resources you access.

IP Addresses and Cookies

We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type and we may collect information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on the hard drive of your computer. Cookies are small text files that contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. They help us to improve our site and to deliver a better and more personalised service. They enable us to:

- estimate our audience size and usage pattern;
- store information about your preferences, and so allow us to customise our site according to your individual interests;
- speed up your searches; and
- recognise you when you return to our site.

The cookies used by this website and their purpose are identified and described below. We will seek your consent to use cookies the first time you visit this website (or on subsequent occasions if the cookie that records such acceptance is deleted). Denial of the cookies used by this website may prevent parts of the website from working properly.

Cookie - mainstainsid. Name - Set Cookie Header Cookie. Purpose - tells the browser to store the data in a text file.

Cookie - utma. Name - Google Analytics Tracking Cookie. Purpose - stores the amount of visits for each visitor to the site, the time of the first visit, the previous visit, and the current visit.

Cookie - utmb and utmc. Name - Google Analytics Tracking Cookies. Purpose - used to check approximately when a visit starts, ends and how fast people leave the site.

Cookie - utmz. name - Google Analytics Tracking Cookie. Purpose - determines whether or not access to the site came via a search engine (eg Google).

Most web browsers allow some user control of most cookies through the browser settings. You have the ability to accept or decline cookies by modifying the settings in your browser. For information on changing these settings, please look for a "help" function in the browser or contact the browser provider. However, you may not be able to use all the interactive features of our site if cookies are disabled.

Storing Your Data

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the European Economic Area ("EEA"). It may also be processed by staff operating outside the EEA who work for us or another company in our group. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

Using Your Information

We may use information held about you in the following ways:

- to ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;
- to contact you where you have requested information from us or have reported a problem with our site and to respond to any information you have provided in respect of a job advertisement on our site or any site linked to our site or your interest in employment opportunities; and
- to notify you about changes to our service.

Disclosure

We may disclose your personal information to any company in our group, which means our subsidiaries, our ultimate holding company and its subsidiaries, as defined in section 736 of the UK Companies Act 1985 (as amended).

We may disclose your personal information to third parties in the event that we sell or buy any business or assets; if ARAMARK Limited or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party; if we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our [Terms of Use](#) and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of ARAMARK Limited, our customers or others.

Your Rights

You have the right to ask us not to process your personal data for marketing purposes. We will usually inform you (before collecting your data) if we intend to use your data for such purposes or if we intend to disclose your information to any third party for such purposes. You can exercise your right to prevent such processing by checking certain boxes on the forms we use to collect your data. Access to Information
